

Create your own flock out of pom poms!

YOU WILL NEED:

Scissors Cardboard Ball of white wool Glue Wobbly eyes (optional)



STEP 1

Choose your sheep, trace around the corresponding doughnut template on to 2 pieces of card and cut them out.

Be careful when using sharp scissors — ask an adult to help.

STEP 2

Put the two pieces of card together then tie the end of the wool around them. Start passing your wool through the centre of the card and wind the wool evenly around the doughnut shape.





STEP 3

Keep winding the wool around your cardboard template until it is completely covered and there is hardly a gap in the middle anymore. The more layers of wool, the thicker and woollier your finished sheep will be!

STEP 4

Using scissors, carefully cut around the outside edge of the doughnut, freeing the ends of the threads.

(It helps to get the scissors in between the two pieces of cardboard). This can be tricky so you may need help from an adult.







STEP 5

When this is done, slide a piece of wool between the two pieces of card and tie it really tightly around the centre of the pom pom, bringing the pieces of wool together and tie a knot. Then cut away the cardboard rings. Puff out the wool to create a full and fluffy pom pom.

STEP 6

Next you will need to give your sheep a head and legs! Choose which parts you want to use, then stick them to some sturdy card, and once the glue is dry cut them out.





STEP 7

You will now need to glue the parts on to the body. Stick the head to the front section

of your pom pom. Fold the legs along the dotted lines and glue the pom pom to sit on top ot it. Your sheep is now complete!

STEP 8

Once you have finished your sheep, why not try a bigger, more rounder pom-pom for Shirely, or a tiny one for Timmy?
